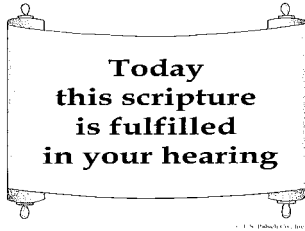

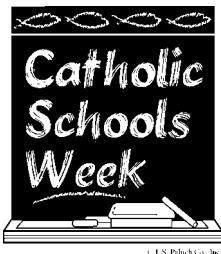
UNANNOUNCED MASSES
